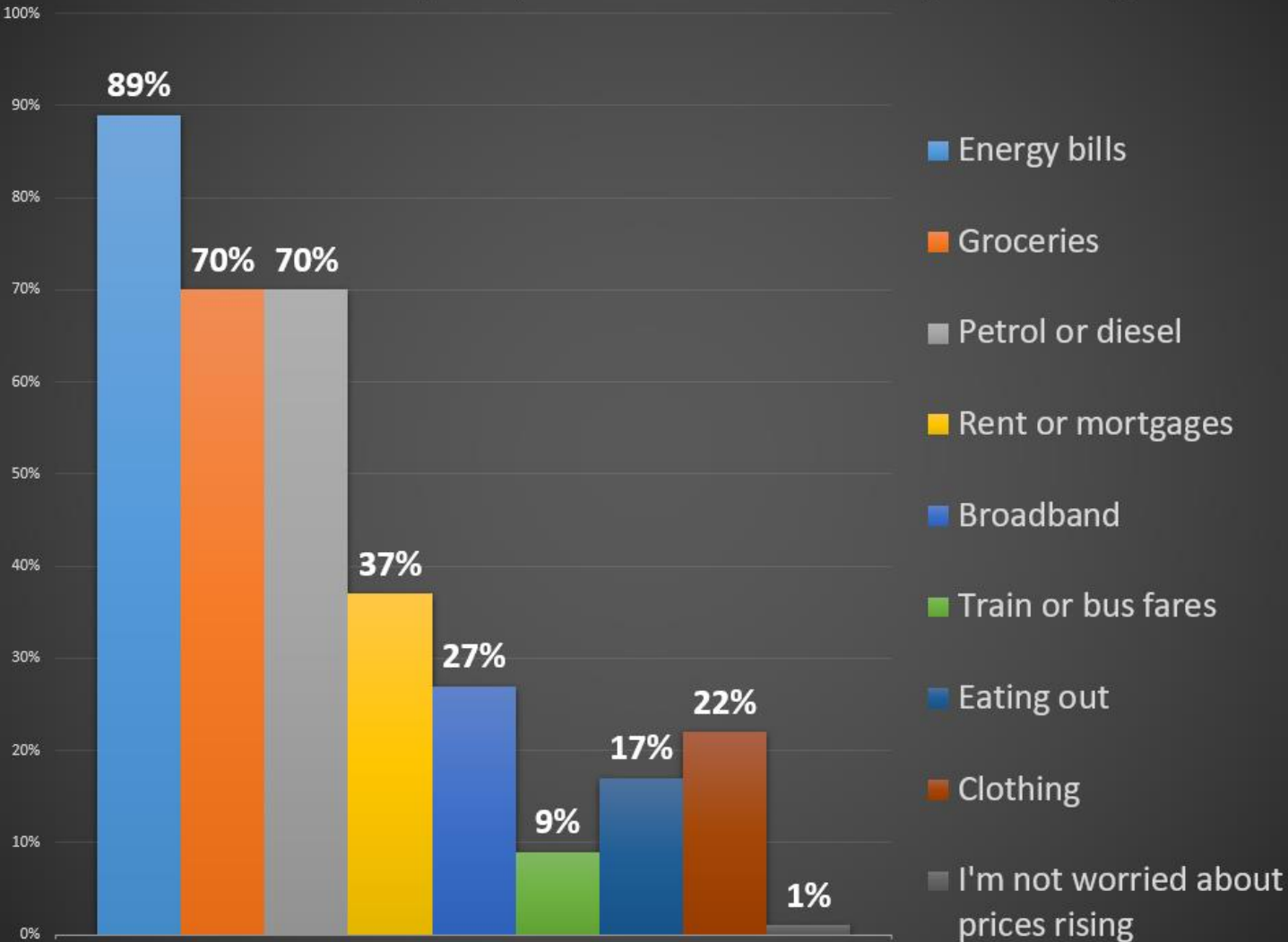

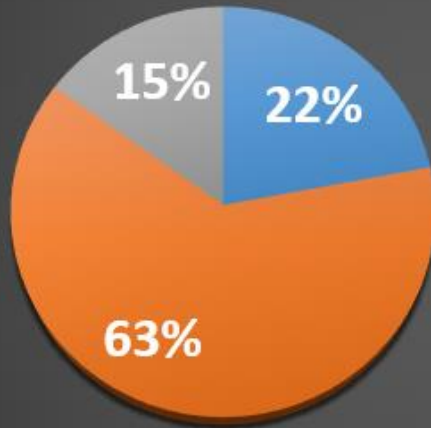

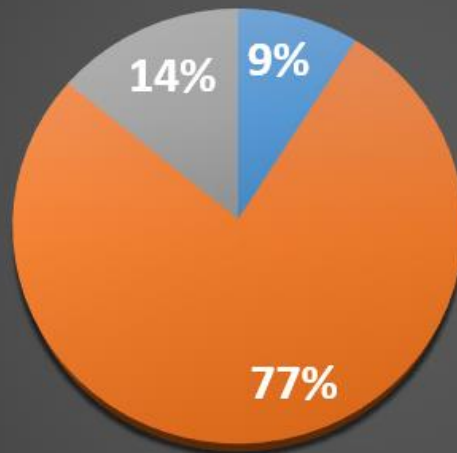


Which of the following is closest to your view?

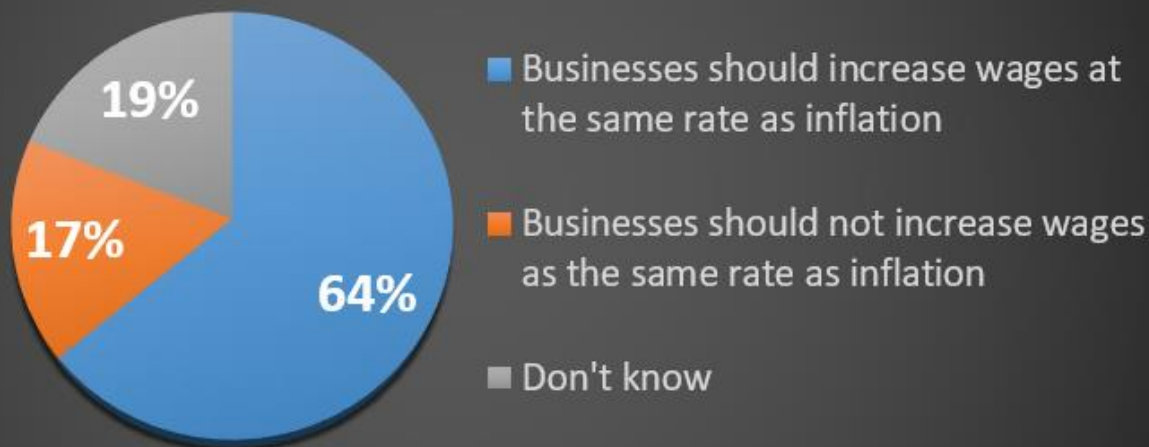

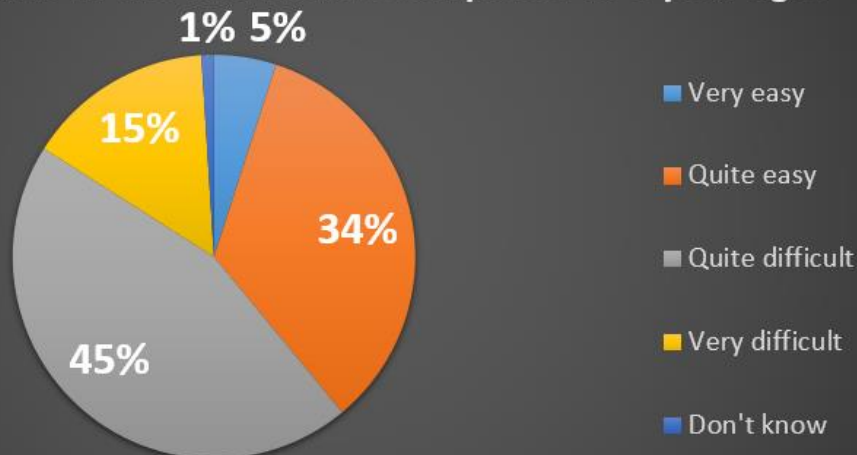

How easy or difficult has it been to pay your usual household bills in the last month compared to a year ago?



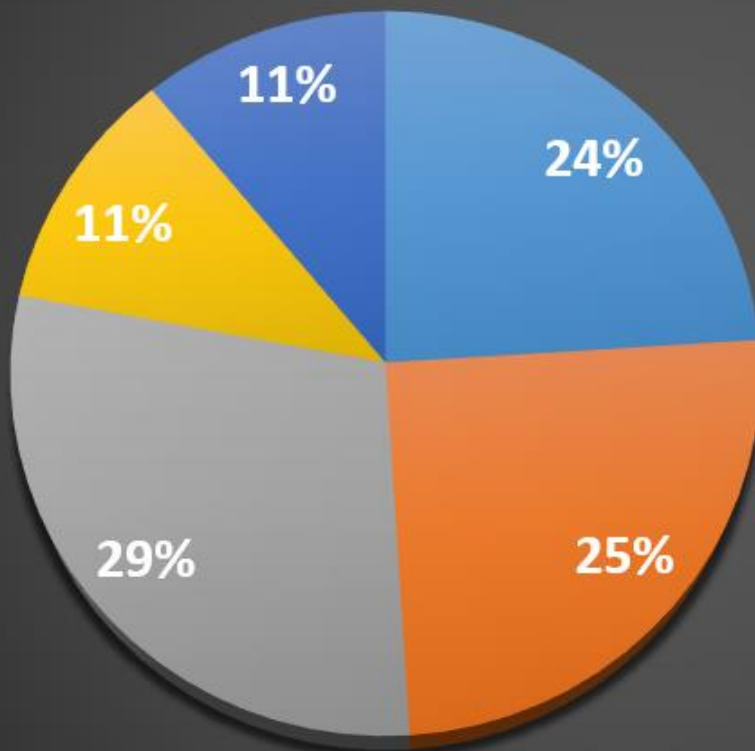

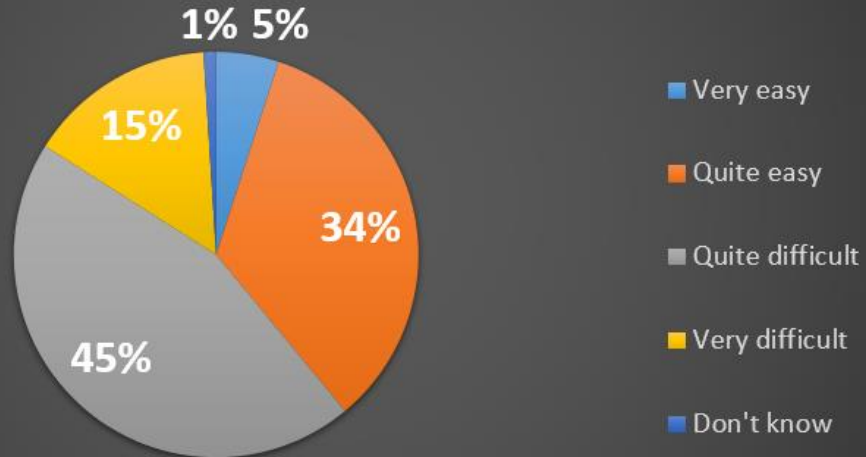

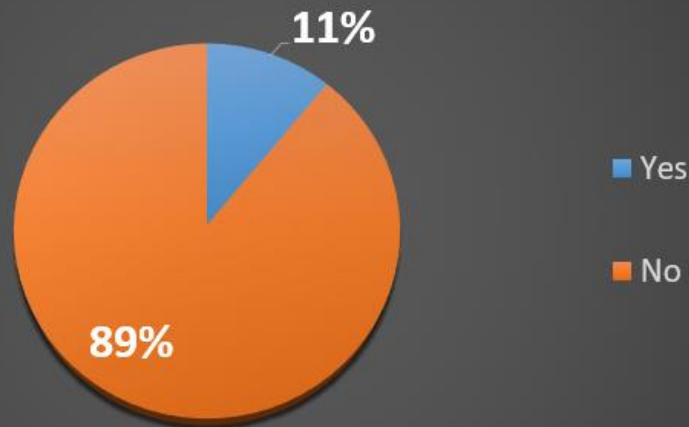

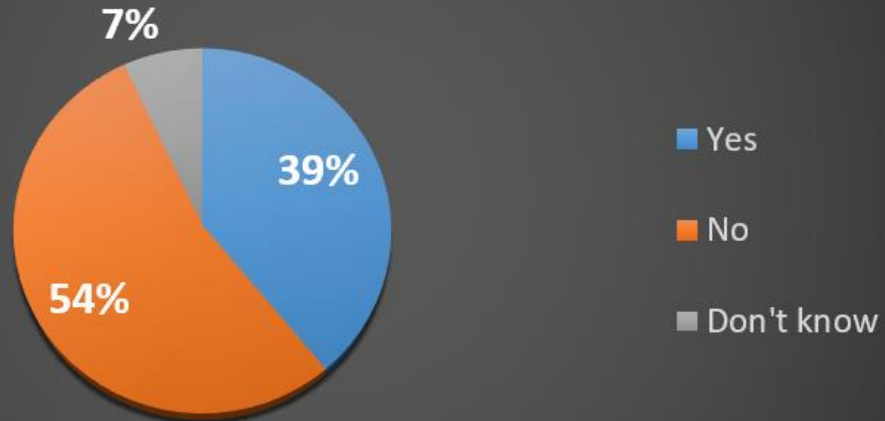

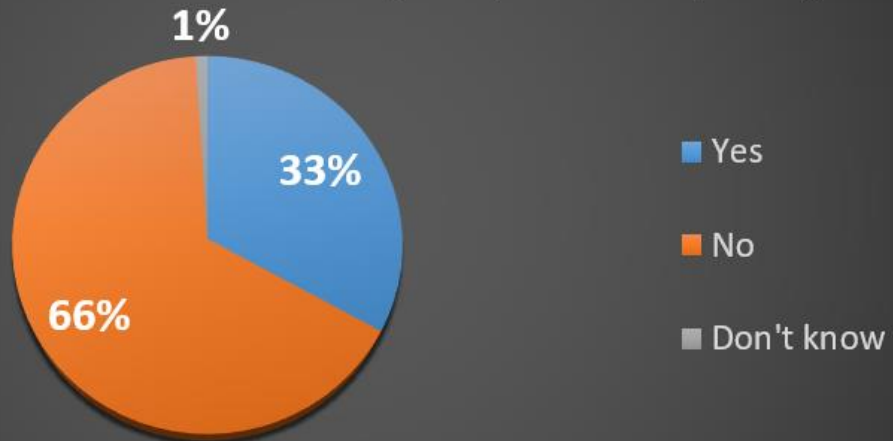
